Mathias Loewen, 52, passed away April 17, 2020.

Mathias was born in Brazil, grandson of German missionaries. He was the son of Hildegard Meizer Loewen of Brazil and the late Rudolf Klassen Loewen. He was an outstanding engineer and passionate for his job and for the people he worked with at SEW Eurodrive, and as project manager was instrumental in the construction of the new plant in Duncan. Mathias' greatest joy was to be a servant of the Lord and his goal, no matter the outcome of his illness, was that the name of the Lord was glorified. He was a member of Taylors First Baptist Church, where he taught the First Grade Sunday School Class for several years.

Surviving are his wife, Doroti Loewen of the home; three sons, Jonathan Loewen, Daniel Loewen and Silas Loewen all of Germany; two sisters, Conny Kroker (Harri) and Karin Frose (Francisco) all of Brazil; brother-in-law, Daniel Pereira (Regiani) of Hickory, North Carolina; and two nephews, Lucas and Nathan Pereira of Hickory, North Carolina.
