A native of Queens, New York, son of Charles F. Kelly of Greensboro, North Carolina and the late Patricia A. Ryan Kelly. He was a U.S. Navy Veteran, a retired FDNY/911 Hero/firefighter Engine 290 in Brooklyn, N.Y., and an employee of Greenville County School District. He was of the Baptist faith.
