



## Nina M. Hall

May 5, 1934 - June 15, 2022

Nina Medford Hall, 88, widow of Ronald Erwin Hall, passed away on June 15, 2022. She died at home surrounded by family, after a long battle with dementia.

A native of Clyde, North Carolina, she was the daughter of the late Fred Lane and Pauline Davis Medford. She was a retired employee of Greenville County School District where she worked as school secretary at Wade Hampton Elementary, then Riverside High School.
