



## Alfred Elworthy

Alfred S. Elworthy, age 84 of Greer, South Carolina died, July 12, 2015 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

In addition to his wife Viveca, he is survived by five sons, one daughter and six grandchildren.

Visitation will be held between 3pm and 4pm, on Friday, July 17, 2015 at the Wood Mortuary, 300 W Poinsett St., Greer, South Carolina.

After five years with Hanes, he retired to Florida in the Sarasota area and then moved to South Carolina in 2005.

Al's first wife, Elaine, had passed away after 19 years of marriage when he was fortunate again to meet and marry another special lady, Viveca, in 1972.
