Alton Comos Free, 90, of 12323 Greenville Highway, widower of Sybil Glenn Free, died Tuesday, January 29, 2008 at Spartanburg Regional Hospice House.

Born March 1, 1917 in Madison County, Georgia to the late Henry C. and Nina Wooten Free and lived most of his adult life in Spartanburg County. He was a retired employee of Springs Industries and a member of Duncan First Baptist Church. Mr. Free also served in the US Army Air Corp.

He was Past Master of Irving Southworth Masonic Lodge 350 and member for 66 years. He was a 33rd degree Scottish Rite Mason with membership in the Spartanburg and Greenville Scottish Rite bodies.

Surviving are two sons and daughter-in-law, Alton Free of the home and Aaron and Karen Free of Lyman; one grandson, Joey and Heather Free; two great-grandchildren, Taylor Free and Zeke Whitman; and special members of his extended family, Brenda McMillan of Duncan and Christine McMillan of Lyman.

Mr. Free was predeceased by one brother, J.T. Free; two sisters, Dorothy High and Hazel Warnock and one grandson, Jason Free.

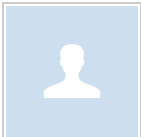
