“ Anjanette was an absolutely beautiful girl, back when we were friends in Greer High School. We were maybe 17 years old, back in 1988, when I knew her. We used to cut class every once in a while, and we would go to Piggy's bbq hut, then feed the ducks down at this little creek behind a restaurant on Hwy 14. During one trip to feed the ducks, we crossed the road and jumped this fence that was chained shut by the power company, because there was a small dam over there, with a 2 or 3 foot wide concrete slab that ran across to the other side of the lake. We walked out on that "slab", or concrete wall, looking down over the side, realizing how high up we were, but we stood right there, arm in arm, just she and I, laughing, and getting our picture taken by our mutual friend, Amy. I recall this "thing" Angie used to do with her eyes, as a funny face, but oh my gosh! I would just roll with laughter until I had tears running down my cheeks!. She was hilariously funny. I loved being around Anjanette. That girl had talent. She could always sing so much better than I. Her voice was so clear, and she could carry a note like nobody's business. My life was better for having known Angie. I miss my friends, and I am deeply saddened over this tragedy. I am so sorry for my late entry. I just found out about her passing, as I live in Liverpool, NY. I would like to send her husband , her children, and her mother, Marlene, my personal condolences. There are very few things that people can say in times like this. I will never forget Angie. She was very special.
