Ann (Dee) V. D'Angelo, age 100, of Greer, SC, beloved mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother, went to be with the Lord on Friday, January 14, 2011. She was predeceased by her husband of 73 years, Matthew D'Angelo on August 8, 2005. She was the daughter of the late Anthony and Barbara D'Aiuto.

She was born in Derby, CT, September 5, 1910. After her marriage to Matt, she resided in Oradell, NJ 40 years before moving to Boca Raton, FL.
