Annette Parris Clayton, 70, widow of Roy James Clayton, Sr., died February 27, 2015 at her home.

A native of Spartanburg County, she was a daughter of the late Henry and Thelma Mills Parris, and a member of Holly Springs Baptist Church. Annette was a bookkeeper at D.R.
