On Sunday, December 10, 2006, following a courageous battle with cancer, Ann Shockley Veazey beheld the face of her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Born May 6, 1937, Ann was the daughter of the late Hubert S. Shockley and the late Callie Berry Shockley of Taylors. She attended Taylors High School and Mars Hill College, in Mars Hill, N.C.

For 45 years, Ann shared her life and a loving marriage with her husband, Walter “Walt” Hutchinson Veazey. During their union, they were blessed with a daughter, Dalinda Lorraine Veazey.

Ann and Walt were long-time members of Taylors First Baptist Church. Ann loved the beach and among her happiest times were those spent with her family at Myrtle Beach. She was a devoted Clemson Tigers and Atlanta Braves fan, and an avid bridge player.
