Arthur Steven Cooke, Jr., 84, of 818 Marue Drive, died July 18, 2006 at St. Francis Hospital.

A native of Forsyth County, North Carolina, son of the late Arthur Cooke, Sr. and Neoma Bullock Cooke, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, a retired sales manager for Johnson Controls, and a member of Dunean United Methodist Church. He was a lifetime member of Walden Masonic Lodge since 1956, past master of Dunean Lodge, past district deputy grandmaster 1973-1975, and served as Grand Pursuivant in 1970.
