Barbara "Barb" Ann Bulvony Keryan, 75, passed away in the early morning of November 30, 2021, after a long illness.

A native of Warren, Ohio, and an Upstate resident since 1994; she was a daughter of the late John Andrew and Alvina "Betty" Kurtz Bulvony. Barb was a graduate of Akron University with a degree in Social Work and later became a social worker.
