



## Barbara Cox

March 15, 1934 - November 8, 2018

Barbara Freeman Cox, 84, of Moore, peacefully passed away, November 8, 2018, after a brief battle with cancer.

She was born March 15, 1934 in Spartanburg, SC. The daughter of the late Palmer Leland and Bonnie Blackwell Freeman, Barbara graduated from District 5 High School in 1952, which would later become James F. Byrnes High School. *Much love to you and your entire family.*

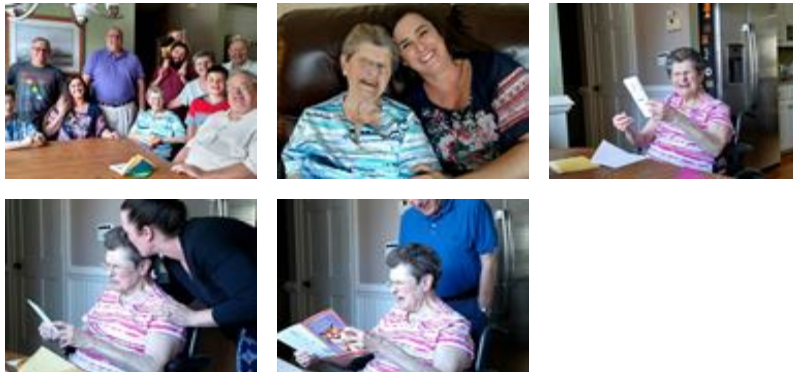
