



Bascombe P. Hall

January 15, 1925 - August 8, 2016

Bascombe Perry Hall, 91, widower of Clara Juanita Holiday Hall, died August 8, 2016 at his home.

A native of Greer, son of the late Odell M. and Lucille Taylor Hall, he was the retired owner/operator of Hall's Barber Shop in Mauldin for 58 years and a US Army WWII Veteran. He was a member of Brushy Creek Baptist Church, Empire Masonic Lodge #213 and a Hejaz Shriner. Mr. Hall and his late wife had been married for 65 years prior to her death in 2012.

Surviving are two daughters and son-in-law, Cathy McCoy (Phil) of Simpsonville and Pam Satterfield of Woodruff; three sons and daughters-in-law, Perry Lee Hall (Brenda), Don Hall (Susan) and Roger O'dell Hall (Angie) all of Greer; one sister, Margaree James (Billy) of Greenville; eleven grandchildren; eighteen great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild. Mr. Hall was predeceased by one brother, Wallace Hall and one grandchild. Funeral services will be held 3:00 p.m. Wednesday, August 10, 2016 at Brushy Creek Baptist Church conducted by Rev. Daniel Messer and Dr. Ralph Carter. Burial will follow in Graceland East Memorial Park with masonic rites and military honors.
