Benjamin Harold Campbell, 86, of 740 West Gap Creek Road, widower of Frances Caldwell Campbell, died August 6, 2007 at White Oak Manor, Tryon, North Carolina.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Thomas Newman and Lunda Jane Frady Campbell, he was a U.S. Army veteran of WWII, a recipient of the Bronze Star, and a lifelong member of Washington Baptist Church.

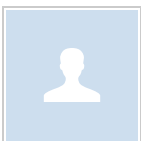
