Bernard Joseph Chevalier, 87, widower of Helen Loraine Chevalier, died May 15, 2009 at Greenville Memorial Hospital, Greenville, S.C.

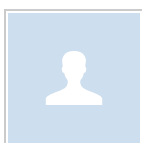
