August 7, 1930 - July 31, 2025

Betty Wood Hamby, 94, went to her heavenly home on July 31, 2025, to meet her savior and join her loving husband, Charles Wilton Hamby, who preceded her in death.

A native of Spartanburg County, she was the daughter of the late Dee A. and Marie McElrath Wood. After retiring from the Greer Shirt Plant, Betty devoted the next 26 years to volunteering at Greer Community Ministries.
