June 6, 1915 - January 16, 2015

Birdiemaë Irene Mullinax Eubanks, 99, widow of Elliott Eubanks, died January 16, 2015 at her home.

A native of Pelzer, SC, daughter of the late Charles Franklin and Maybell Blair Mullinax, and she was a retired employee of M. Lowenstein Mills. She was a faithful member and Sunday school teacher of Lyman First Baptist Church. She was the last surviving member of her family.


