



## Bob Davies

March 18, 1953 - December 10, 2024

Robert Edward, “Bob” Davies passed away December 10, 2024, after 71 years of life and a battle with cancer.

Born in Jersey City, New Jersey, March 18, 1953, son of the late Robert David and Muriel Davies. Bob graduated from Memorial High School, Cedar Grove, New Jersey. He attended Montclair State University, New Jersey, and completed his college degree through Charter Oak State College, Hartford, Connecticut. Mr. Davies served in the South Carolina National Guard and active duty in the United States Army during the first Persian Gulf War. He served as operations manager at Conbraco Industries, Conway, South Carolina, and was a member of Prince of Peace Catholic Church, Taylors, South Carolina.

In 2012, he returned to his Catholic faith after prayerful study of the early church fathers. Their writings stirred in him a strong desire for the Eucharist. In his final days, he found peace in and was sustained by the sacraments. His family and faith were by far the most important things to him, and he loved the outdoors, hiking, reading, poetry, the symphony, and the arts.

Surviving are his wife of 47 years, Kim Davies; his children, Eowyn, Christopher, and Skipper; grandchildren, Rhianwen, Alden, Corwin, Bennett, Elise, Henry, Evelyn, Miles, and Elizabeth Rose; a brother, David Davies; and several loving nieces, nephews, and cousins.

Mr. Davies was predeceased by a sister, Susan Davies Burger.

A funeral mass will be held 10:00 a.m. Monday, December 16, 2024, at Prince
