Brenda Garren Hood, 84, wife of the late Alvin "Sonny" Quinn Hood, passed away October 16, 2025.

Mrs. Hood was a graduate of Greer High School class of 1959, where she played basketball and was the first female inducted into the South Carolina High School Hall of Fame.
