



## Brenda Paquin

December 13, 1942 - August 31, 2024

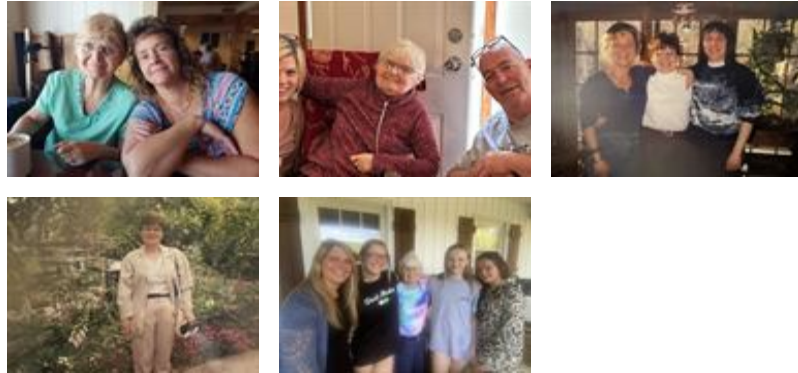

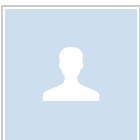
