Carl Milton (Bud) Sloan, 75, of 735 Sloan Road, died October 22, 2006 at Spartanburg Regional Medical Center.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late Otis Odell and Minnie Atkins Sloan, he was a 1952 graduate of Clemson University and a U.S. Army veteran of the Korean Conflict. Mr. Sloan taught at Aiken High School, Fairforest High School and Fairforest Middle School before retiring as a building and construction instructor for R.D. Anderson Vocational School after forty years of service. He was the president of Sloan and Sloan Builders for the past fourteen years. He was a member of Holly Springs Baptist Church, a charter member of the Holly Springs Ruritan Club, former fire chief of Holly Springs V.F.D., and a former Little League coach at Holly Springs.

Surviving are his wife, Flora Lee Bell Sloan of the home; two sons and daughters-in-law, Joe and Kim S. Sloan and Travis and Kim T. Sloan all of Holly Springs; four grandchildren, Brett Sloan, Drew Sloan, Kylie Sloan, and Turner Sloan; six sisters, Myra S. Weatherly and Audrey S. Bowers both of Greer, Peggy S. Wisterman, Patsy S. Turner, Linda S. Henderson, and Cheryl Sloan Smith all of Holly Springs; and one sister-in-law, Virginia D. Sloan of Holly Springs.
