“ In 4 days it will be one year since Pop died. It still seems unreal to me that he's gone, every time I go to his house it's like a part of that house is missing. Pop isn't there to sit in that recliner and watch the news. He isn't there to drink his coffee and read the paper. He isn't there to lecture me on boys while swinging on the back porch and telling me all that's going on in this world. He isn't here to worry about us. He won't get to see his great grands grow up which he wanted more than anything in this world. He's not gonna be there on Christmas again to scratch his lottery tickers and get his pocket knife he got every year. If there was one thing about my grandpa it was that he cared for his family more than anything in this world and never wanted to leave us behind. His smile brightened up the entire room he was in, if I close my eyes I can still see it, I can see him holding up his index finger pointing at whoever he was mad at. It wasn't hard to make him mad hahaha. Most of my child hood memories were spent at his house playing with my cousin Jazmine. We stayed for weeks straight and never got bored there. All me and Jazmine did was laugh until 3 am in the morning and little did we know Pop could hear it over his oxygen tank, but he never came in to tell us to be quiet. That was mama's job but then again I think he enjoyed hearing us laugh because he knew we were just being ourselves. And honestly if me and Jaz ever sat in silence that's when you know something is wrong. The morning after Jaz and I would walk downstairs at 10- 11 am and pop would be sitting in that chair and say "what were you girls laughing at last night, and why are y'all up so late, I got up at 7 am even after y'all kept me up all night. I could go on and on for days about incidents like that.... The older I got the less I went and I start regretting that, I also regret not calling enough. It's hard driving up that hill to go to his house and knowing he's not gonna be there. When I was a little kid I would be about to jump out the car excited going up that hill and I'd run straight down stairs to give him a hug. Now I walk downstairs with a presence of emptiness as he's not there to give me a hug and kiss on the cheek anymore.....He's flying high in a better place and will be watching



down on all of us forever as our guardian angel. Pop, I sure do miss you. Letting go of your hand was the hardest thing I had to do that day in the hospital. Thanks for the life lessons you taught me and for all the love you have given me. I know time will heal, but a part of my heart is going to be missing until I get to see you again. 17 years with you is not enough but It gave me a lifetime of memories I hope I never forget one day.
