



Carmela B. Hudson

July 31, 1920 - December 17, 2017

Carmela B. Hudson, 97, widow of J.E. Hudson, Jr., died December 17, 2017 at her home with family by her side.

Born in New London, Conn., she was a WWII veteran who was commissioned a 2nd Lieutenant in the U.S. Army Nurse Corps after graduating from the Mass General in Boston. She was a mother of four children, a Mema to seven grandchildren and fourteen great-grandchildren, a member of Memorial United Methodist Church, a graduate of Furman University, an elementary teacher, librarian and founder of Greer Heritage Museum.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, December 22, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. at Memorial United Methodist Church in Greer, SC with visitation from 1:30 to 2:45 p.m. in the church sanctuary. Burial to follow at Wood Memorial Park in Duncan.
