Carol Ann Stockton Blake, 72, passed away June 7, 2016.

Born in Texarkana, Arkansas, Carol was the daughter of the late J.M. Stockton and Irene Parker Stockton. She moved to Shreveport, Louisiana as a child where she would meet and later marry her childhood sweetheart, Eugene.

Carol was a devoted wife and mother as well as a talented seamstress, quilter and artist. She studied art at Louisiana Tech University before marriage.
