Rev. Charles Edward Champion, 91, husband of the late Raedean Brown Champion, passed away March 16, 2025.

A native of Chattanooga, Tennessee, son of the late Charles Joseph and Leona Rose Champion, he was a retired Presbyterian Church in America minister. Rev. Champion had a Master of Divinity and had the honor and privilege to serve the Lord in His ministry at Brainerd Hills Presbyterian in various capacities for 20 years.
