Charles Francis Ryan, 87, passed away on April 6, 2025.

A native of Fresno, California, son of the late Charles F. Ryan, Sr., and Mary M. McGuire Ryan, he was a retired Colonel from the United States Air Force and a member of Praise Cathedral and Prince of Peace Catholic Church.

As a committed family leader and man of God, Chuck was faithful to Praise Cathedral Church of God in Greer, SC, alongside his family for over two decades. He was a loyal fan of Praise Cathedral Church basketball, softball, and intramural games and enjoyed serving during the Christmas season.
