Cheryl Jackson Goode, age 79, of Lyman, entered Heaven on Wednesday after a brief illness.

Cheryl was raised in Startex, SC, and graduated from Byrnes High School in 1964. She was married to Fred "Mickey" Goode for 51 years. Mrs. Goode began her career teaching kindergarten at the First Baptist Church of Lyman before continuing at the "Old" Lyman Elementary and River Ridge Elementary Schools. She dedicated 32 years of service to Spartanburg District Five Schools.

Alongside her husband, Mrs. Goode traveled extensively, visiting all 50 states and 16 foreign countries. She was deeply loved and respected in her community and was well known throughout the town of Lyman.

Mrs. Goode is survived by her two sons, Eric and Kevin (Lorie), both of Lyman; four grandchildren, Austin Goode of Florence, Charley Pepper (Adam) of Easley, Hayden Goode of Lyman, and Grant Goode of Lyman; one great-grandchild, Jackson Pepper of Easley; and a brother, Larry Jackson (Sandra) of Columbia.

Her family will miss her dearly, but find peace in knowing she is with her Heavenly Father. She was an exceptional mother, grandmother, and friend. Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Monday, March 3, 2025, at First Presbyterian Church, Spartanburg conducted by Rev. Rachel Klompmaker. Burial will follow in Wood Memorial Park.
