Cliff Olice (C.O.) Hendrix, 93, widower of Frances Bridwell Hendrix, died November 7, 2009 at his residence.

A native of Spartanburg County, son of the late J.O. and Ernestine Wilson Hendrix, he was a retired employee of 38 years from Lyman Printing and Finishing and a member of Abner Creek Baptist Church where he was a member of the Gideon Sunday School class. Mr. Hendrix was a former director from 1948-1949 for the Association of Baptist Training Union for the Spartanburg Association.

Surviving are two brothers, Ralph Hendrix of Columbia and F.E. Hendrix of Duncan; a sister, Irene Hendrix Hadden of Spartanburg; a granddaughter Sherry Hendrix White of Lyman; two great-grandchildren Samantha and Michael Parker of Lyman and a number of nieces and nephews.

Mr. Hendrix was predeceased by a son, Lowell C. Hendrix.

Funeral services will be held 11:00 a.m. Monday at Woods Chapel United Methodist Church conducted by Rev. Vernon Thornhill and Rev. Scott Ogel. Burial will follow in Abner Creek Baptist Church cemetery.
