Clinton (Smitty) Smith, 86, of Greenville, SC died Sunday, January 16, 2011. Born in Greer, SC, he was the only child of the late Effie Sandlin Smith and H. Randolph Smith of the Flatwood Community.

Clint graduated from Duncan High School in 1941, was a World War II U.S. Navy veteran, who served in the Pacific Theater, and was a 32nd degree Mason. Smitty served the City of Greenville for 42 years. He first worked as a traffic policeman for 22 years; the next 20 years, he served as the city parking garage manager, and retired in 1990.

His wife of 63 years, Doris Duncan Smith, died October 10, 2010.

He is survived by daughters, Gail Moon (Hubert), Janie Dillard (Ronny), and Yvette Bates (Randy), along with seven grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

In addition to his wife and parents, Clint was predeceased by a son, Richard Earl Smith.
