Colin Douglas Heaton, 78, passed away June 23, 2021 after a courageous 2 year battle with cancer.

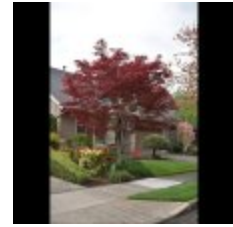
