On August 9, 2022, Cruz prayed the salvation prayer to receive Christ Jesus into his heart and soul. Just as Jesus said, “It is finished.” On the cross, the battle for Cruz’s eternity was “finished” and won that day. Hallelujah for the cross! Hallelujah for an eternal home in a restored Eden. While Cruz is celebrating being made whole with Jesus as of September 4th, 2023, his best guy, Cookie the Pug, is residing with his family at 23 Arbolado Way, Greer, SC. 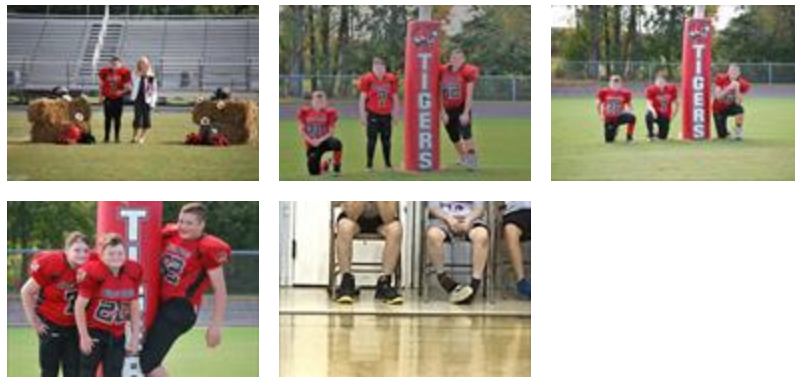
