Damon sat in my barber chair (my kitchen high-top chair) just Thursday for his monthly hair cut, shave and beard trim. We talked about the Lord, Jesus which he always wanted to teach me more about the bible as much as I wanted to learn, more eager to hear him witness and spread the Word of God. Damon was a man of God, he was a child of God's and he wanted everyone to know he was going to walk those Gold Streets of Heaven, he was going to run and jump as high as he possibly could with no pain streaming through his body and mind! Damon said something to me Thursday, something somewhat different from other high-chair visits, he said "Sha-Sha, I cannot wait to see my mother and father and I know you can't wait to see Debo again, we will soon just keep the faith." He shaved his face before he came to the house, when he sat in the chair I said Damon, I know you didn't shave, that's my job, let me take care of you! He returned with the biggest smile I've ever seen, grinning from ear to ear to say, "Sha-Sha, I'm going home with this look." He hugged me, kissed me on the cheek and said thank you and we talked more before he left. I so wonder if he knew he would be meeting his Lord the following Sunday. I so wonder if he knew his time was near! I know he was handsome and ready to meet his Lord. Damon brought laughter, love, compassion, healing, prayers and most of all, he gave all he could give to anyone he came in contact with. My Papa-D (Damon and I started a lawn service business in 2003 and the name of our business was of course "Papa D's Lawn Care" the name stuck to him from that day forward. I am happy that he is in Heaven and I have another Angel watching over me and "Angels at my feet" as he always told me. Through the years, with Damon and Sharon, he nicknamed her Sha, Damon was my brother-in-law even if the two were only

companions, he was one of my very best friends and only God knows the stories we've shared over the years. I will miss the laughs, the giggles, the smiles, the text messages, my very own personal praying sessions that we had. I feel his presence here with me as I write these memories of him, hearing him say "keep the faith, know your Lord, do not be sad that I am no longer with you, but be Happy and Rejoice that I am now home in no more pain as I am walking, running and jumping through the Streets of Gold with Jesus."
