Deborah "Debbie" Denise Dobson Moore, 72, passed away April 21, 2026. A native of Greer, daughter of the late Edward Dennis Dobson, Sr. and Frances Emmeline McGill Dobson, she was a member of First Presbyterian Church, Greer. She earned her Bachelor of Science in Nursing from Nell Hodgson Woodruff School of Nursing at Emory University, her Master of Health Administration from the Medical University of South Carolina, and Master of Science in Nursing from Clemson University School of Nursing; she was a nurse and nurse practitioner for 50 years.

Surviving are her son, Dr. Scott Emory Moore of Cleveland, Ohio, her brother, Edward Dennis Dobson, Jr. (Sandra) of Greenville, South Carolina, her nephew, Jonathan Lyons Dobson (Kirstin) of Bellevue, Washington, and her dearest friend, David Vincent Duncan of Greer, South Carolina. Ms. Moore is predeceased by her parents and nephew, Allan McGill Dobson.
