Dennis Ray Gosnell, 61, of 915 N. Glassy Mountain Road, died August 6, 2006 at his home.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Loyd Lovely and Alice Hughes Gosnell, he was a retired dispatcher with the South Carolina Highway Patrol and a member of Glassy Mountain Church of God. He was also a member of the Church of God Senior Adult Choir, South Carolina.
