August 25, 1942 - December 2, 2014

Douglas MacArthur Rogers, 72, widower of Mary Ellen Godfrey Rogers, died December 2, 2014 at his home.

A native of Spartanburg County, he was a son of the late John Oliver and Lula Elizabeth Cox Rogers, a retired employee of Circor International, a member of Loree United Methodist Church and was a U.S. Army veteran.
