Douglas Henry Rogier, 72, died July 23, 2016.

A native of Rand, West Virginia, son of the late George Henry and Mildred Amick Rogier, he was a retired employee of Johnson Electric Co. and a member of Colonial Hills Baptist Church. He was an amateur radio operator and had worked with local emergency services. Mr. Rogier was a board member for 25 years of The Anchorage Camp at Lake Waccamaw, North Carolina.
