Dr. Grady Leroy Green, 84, of 375 Rosedale Drive, died May 16, 2007 at his home. Dr. Green was married to the late Gloria Pittman Green for 56½ years. A native of Rock Hill, son of the late Carl W. and Leslie Watts Green, he was a Army WWII Veteran and a member of Tabernacle Baptist Church. Dr. Green was a graduate of B.B.I. Dr. Green pastored in Florida, South Carolina, North Carolina and Virginia; he was the author of seven volumes of "Preach Preacher Preach" and was a Radio Minister on WTBI. He was a Visitation Pastor at Tabernacle Baptist on White Horse Road for the last 15 years, a professor at the Tabernacle Bible College, and assistant Sunday school teacher of the Auditorium Bible class.

Surviving are three daughters and sons-in-law, Bobbi and J.L. Perry, Pat and Don Stephens, Joy and John Quintilliani all of Greer; a sister, Grace Green of Rock Hill; six grandchildren, six great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.

In addition to his wife, Dr. Green was predeceased by a sister and two brothers.

Funeral services will be held 2:00 p.m. Friday at Tabernacle Baptist Church conducted by Dr. Melvin Aiken and Rev. Reuben Shepherd. Committal service will be held at 5:30 p.m. Friday in Laurelwood Cemetery, Rock Hill.
