



## Dr. Neil Frederick Wyss

October 22, 1944 - September 16, 2011

Neil Frederick Wyss, 66, of Greer peacefully passed away at his home on September 16, 2011.

Born October 22, 1944 in Sheffield, England, he was a son of the late Frederick Wyss Jr. and Pamela Baker Wyss. He graduated from the Medical College of Virginia Dental School and practiced dentistry in Lyman for 35 years. Dr. Wyss served as a captain in the US Army Dental Corps for 3 years. He was elected to the school board of Spartanburg School District #5 for a number of years. Dr. Wyss was a member of Memorial United Methodist Church in Greer.

Surviving is his wife, Kathy of the home, two daughters, Heather Wyss Bland and her husband, Julian, of Greenville and Kristin Wyss of the home, one sister, Christine Parsons and her husband, Jim, of Greenville and a loving and extended family.
