Duane Collins Clark, 67, of 7 East Heathwood Drive, died October 22, 2006 at St. Francis Hospital.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Henry Collins Clark of Milledgeville, Georgia and Loeta Duncan Clark of Greer, he was a U.S. Army veteran, a commercial hot air balloon pilot, and attended St. Andrews Presbyterian Church.

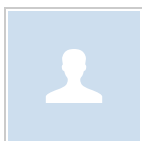
