Earl Felix Albritton, Jr., 66, of 109 Pine Hill Drive, died May 23, 2012 at his residence.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Earl Felix Albritton, Sr., and Jessie Naomi Woods Albritton, he was a U.S. Army Veteran of the Vietnam War and Desert Storm War. Mr. Albritton retired from the Department of Defense where he worked for Area Maintenance Support Activity 127G. Mr. Albritton retired with the rank of Master Sergeant after 29 years of active and reserve service, a member of the VFW and of Victorian Hills Community Church.
