January 26, 1939 - January 24, 2021

Tyree Edward Hyatt, 81, passed into eternal life on January 24, 2021.

A native of Greer, son of the late Tyree Walter and Mae Masters Hyatt Scott, he was born January 26, 1939. Edward attended Wofford College, spent 3 years in the United States Army and retired after 37 years with BellSouth. 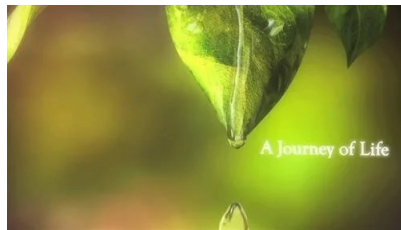

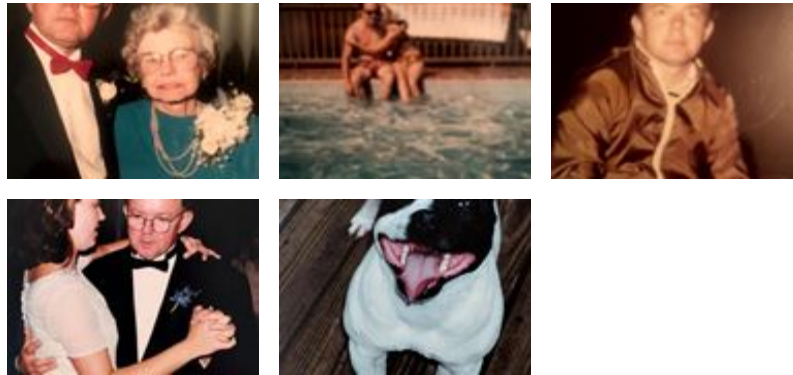
