Edna Cannon Hamrick (Ann mama), 87, of 10410 Greenville Highway, entered heavenly peace on Wednesday, January 25, 2012 at Spartanburg Regional Hospice Home. Born in May 27, 1924, she was a daughter of the late Lou Hampton and C. Parker Cannon. The youngest of ten children, she was the last surviving member of her immediate family. She was predeceased by her devoted husband of 68 years, Richard Andrew Hamrick, on July 25, 2011. For most of her life she was a loyal member of Startex United Methodist Church, serving on various committees and as an adult Sunday school teacher. Recently, she moved her membership to Lyman United Methodist Church. She and Richard delivered Mobile Meals and were active members of the Startex Retirees.

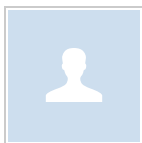

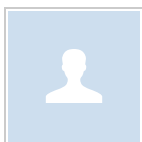

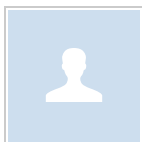
