E.E. (Al) Kennedy, 86, of 106 Laurel Road, widower of Betty Jean Tinsley Kennedy, died April 19, 2011 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of Lincoln, Nebraska, son of the late George Albert and Helen Slusser Kennedy, he was a U.S. Navy veteran of WWII, a retired project manager for Lockwood Greene, and a member of Greer First Baptist Church. He was a volunteer for Greer Community Ministries Mobile Meals.

Surviving are two daughters, Vicki Kennedy and Laura K. Aiken both of Greer; a son, Buster Kennedy of Piedmont; three grandchildren, James P. 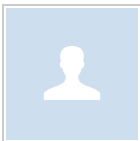
