Ellen May Messer Williams, 81, widow of Perrin Hasting Williams, passed away July 8, 2017.

A native of Hudson, Ohio, she was a daughter of the late Ellis and Ruth Fuller Messer, retired insurance claims approver, graduate of Clemson University and a member of Christ the King Lutheran Church. Ellen had a 25-year history with Habitat Greenville, being one of the earliest volunteers with the Greenville affiliate and served on the Board of Directors. Her specialty was landscape management and procurement. She also donated thousands of hours of community service to local organizations.

Surviving are two daughters, Vanna Hinkle of Fountain Inn and Annette Stanton (Steven) of Spartanburg; one son, Gene Williams (Crystal) of North Augusta, SC; six grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
