May 10, 1927 - July 26, 2013

Elmer Boyce Duncan, 86, of S. Glassy Mountain Road, died July 26, 2013 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

A native of Greenville County, son of the late Hiriam Boyce and Carrie Belle Atkins Duncan, he was a U.S. Army Veteran during the Korean War, a former employee of Pilot Life Insurance Company, and a retired employee of Greenville County Road and Bridge Department. He was past commander of D.A.V. Chapter 39 Greer and a member of Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, where he was a former deacon and training union director.

Surviving are his wife, Carrie Lee Burrell Duncan of the home; two daughters, Thelma Owings (Joe) and Wanda Green all of Greer; three grandchildren, Hannah Lawrence, Woody Owings, and Chris Owings; and eight great-grandchildren.

Mr. Duncan was predeceased by his step-mother, Annie Maude Crowe Duncan, three brothers, C.J., Ralph, and Olin Duncan, and sisters, Helon Duncan and his twin sister, Thelma Duncan.
