Eugene Hyrum Payne, 90, passed away at home on Tuesday, November 27, 2018.

Mr. Payne was born in Bedford County, Virginia, a son of the late O. F. Payne and Mattie Dooley Payne. He was a graduate of Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, Virginia; an educator and businessman; a life-long member of Virginia Commonwealth University Alumni Association, American Legion Post #3 and a life-long Christian. He was a member of Roper Mountain Baptist Church. Additionally, he was a U.S. Army Quartermaster Corps veteran, having served in the Aleutian Islands and Continental U.S. from August 26, 1946 until July 2, 1949.
