Evelyn Davis was a lover of animals, nature, sewing, an avid Clemson Fan, loved traveling daily to her favorite restaurants in Spartanburg, Anderson, and Clemson, and enjoyed talking to her family, customers, and childhood friends like, Kathleen Wilson, every night on the telephone, while watching her favorite preachers and gospel singers on Channel 16.

She maintained an enthusiastic and personal interest in all matters of the members of her family. If there was a trip to be taken, a family event to attend—a wedding, a ballgame, a dance recital, a parade, a special honor—she found a way to always attend and show how proud she was.
