Frances Burnett Harrison, widow of James Wilson Harrison, died Wednesday, February 23, 2011 at McCall Hospice House in Simpsonville.

A Christian, Frances was a member of Liberty Hill United Methodist Church most of her life, later attending Springwell Church in Taylors until health issues led her to First Baptist Spartanburg and Taylors First Baptist Church television ministries. She was faithful and most appreciative of all television ministries. Frances graduated from Duncan High School and was a homemaker. She was a devoted caregiver to her husband, Wilson, during his lengthy illness with Multiple Sclerosis.

Frances always took pride in making her yard a neat, beautiful place for all to enjoy. Planting seasonal flowers and even cutting grass were an enjoyment up until the time her health began to fail.

She is survived by her daughter, Patricia (Pat) Harrison Allen and son-in-law, Billy J. (B.J.) Allen of Taylors, with whom she lived these last several years.
