April 16, 1932 - February 14, 2020

Frances Tripp Henderson Hipp, 87, passed away February 14, 2020.

A native of Greenville County, daughter of the late Noah and Ethel Reid Tripp, she was a retired employee of Milliken, Armitage Plant, a retired employee of Hipp Plumbing, and a member of Peoples Baptist Church, where she was a Sunday School teacher.
