Frankie Gwendolyn Robertson Boling, 93, born June 8, 1928, in Duncan, South Carolina, to Anna Belle Carver Robertson and John Thomas Robertson, passed away July 23, 2021.

She married J.E. "Dutch" Boling in 1951; they were married for sixty years. Frankie graduated from Brevard College and the Spartanburg General Hospital School of Nursing. During her nursing career she touched many lives, beginning with her first job at the Shriner's Hospital for Crippled Children in Greenville. For eighteen years, Frankie was a certified Rehabilitation Nurse with Liberty Mutual Insurance Company. She specialized in Worker's Compensation cases. She played a significant role in bringing Hospice to the State of South Carolina.

Surviving are two sons, Scott Boling and his wife, Gina of Hoschton, Georgia and Karl Boling and his wife, Stacey of Flowery Branch, Georgia. They have seven "wonderful" grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. Frankie has two sisters, Gail Davis and Jo Ann Eubanks.

She was preceded in death by two sisters, Johnnie Jordan and Theresa Reed.

A memorial service will be held 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 28, 2021, at The Wood Mortuary Chapel, conducted by Rev. Mike Bingham.
